Rosemount Avenue door

Passed by 4 to 0 vote at the legally noticed, public meeting of ANC1D on June 5, 2007, with a quorum present.

Resolved, that ANC1D advises the Historic Preservation Review Board to permit the replacement door installed at 2017 Rosemount Avenue NW.

Why: the door is almost invisible from any public space, being hidden under a deep front porch, and turned to face to the side. Because it is practically invisible from the sidewalk, it does not disrupt the harmony of the architecture of the area. Compatibility, according to the regulations, requires only a harmonious relationship, not historical authenticity. There is no good reason for requiring the residents to remove their new replacement door and replace with one that qualifies as "Tudor Revival", and is equally invisible from the public space.
