Minutes of the special June 19, 2007 meeting of Advisory Neighborhood Commission 1-D

These minutes approved at the July 11, 2007 meeting.

Call to order

[7:14 pm] Gregg Edwards called the special meeting to order at 7:14 pm. Present were four of the six ANC 1D Commissioners: Gregg Edwards, Jane Zara, Dave Bosserman, and Jack McKay. The announced purpose of the special meeting was informal discussion among the commissioners of ANC issues.

Public discussion

[7:17 pm] **Claudia Schlosberg** confirmed that the ABC Board hearing for Don Jaime's had been postponed, and would be rescheduled for perhaps a month from now. She said that Hear Mount Pleasant had, at this time, protested only the renewals for Haydee's and Don Jaime's. Replying to a question from Jack, she said that the letters sent by ABRA to protest petition signers concerning Corado's and Marx were in error. **Mary Lord**, a candidate for the Board of Education, addressed the audience.

Commission informal discussion

[7:25 pm] The Commission agreed to discuss the current effort to develop a Responsible Hospitality Partnership system for Mount Pleasant.

Mount Pleasant Responsible Hospitality Partnership policy

[8:15 pm] Dave moved the following:

Resolved, that ANC1D adopts the following as a policy statement:

1. A new Mount Pleasant hospitality management umbrella organization will be called the Mount Pleasant Responsible Hospitality Partnership.
2. The purposes of the Mount Pleasant Responsible Hospitality Partnership will be (1) to increase the cultural vitality and diversity and economic viability for both businesses and residents; and (2) to actively mitigate nuisances.

3. The initial governing board of the Mount Pleasant Responsible Hospitality Partnership will be made up of representatives of Mount Pleasant residents, merchants and liquor license licensees, and community groups.
4. The Mount Pleasant Responsible Hospitality Partnership's initial governing board will meet soon to set up the mission, structure, and rules of the organization.

Approved by four to zero vote.

Commission informal discussion (resumed)

[8:31 pm] The Commission continued with an informal discussion, now focusing on affordable housing, inclusionary zoning, and density.

[9:01 pm] Jane moved that the commission adjourn. *Motion passed by unanimous vote.*
